- One candidate for State Treasurer
- One candidate for Commissioner of Insurance
- One candidate for State Representative, 110<sup>th</sup> District
- One candidate for Member, State Board of Education, 5<sup>th</sup> District
- One candidate for District Magistrate Judge, 17th Judicial District, 3<sup>rd</sup> Position
- One candidate for County Commissioner 1<sup>st</sup> District
- One candidate for Township Clerk; Almena, Center, Highland & Solomon Townships

The following officers will be elected in each political party which has qualified to participate in the Primary Election:

- One Precinct Committeeman in each Precinct
- One Precinct Committeewoman in each Precinct

The deadline for filing is June 1, 2026, at noon.
