Our records for Final Receiver's Receipts, Patents, and Deeds begin in 1874.

The Register of Deeds' search fee is \$18.00/hour. You will need to pay in advance. If any documents are found, you will be notified. Copies are \$1.00/page. Customers are billed for copies requested before we mail them to you. We search our grantor/grantee books under names of people you believe to have owned real estate in Norton County. You will also need to give a date range for a 10-year period on which to search. If you have a specific legal description, we can search by the land description.

If you know that your ancestors homesteaded their property, we will search in the Homestead books during the years they may have lived in Norton County. Therefore, you will need a time for us to search as well.
