## Notice of Places and Dates Of Registration of Presidential Preference Primary

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the voters of Norton County, Kansas may register to vote at the following places during regular office hours: Norton City Office, Almena City Office, Lenora City Office, Norton County Health and the Norton County Clerk's office.

At 5:00 pm on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2024 the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote.

When a registered voter changes residence from one precinct to another precinct, such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County election officer to be registered. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.

## **Voting Places**

Voting places will be as follows: Almena, Almena Community Center; Center #1, Center #2, Highland #3 in the Courthouse Lobby; Highland #1 and Lenora City in the Lenora Community Building, City of Norton, Ward I, II, and III, Solomon #1, Solomon #2 and Highland #2 vote at the 4-H building.

## **Election Date & Times**

Presidential Preference Primary election day will be March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Poll hours will be from 7:00 am till 7:00 pm.
